

KLMS One-Act Play Guidelines

- Attend all rehearsals for the entirety of rehearsal. Missing more than two unexcused rehearsals is grounds for dismissal from the production.
- If you are sick and miss school, you must also miss rehearsal. Even if you are sick, please e-mail Mrs. Loy to let her know you will not be at rehearsal. Communication is key!
- Be prepared. Your script and a pencil should ALWAYS be at rehearsal.
- Keep your grades up! We are here to help. Your teachers want you involved in extracurricular activities here at KLMS. If you are struggling in a subject, talk to your directors and your teachers. We will help you. However, a failing grade at any IPR and/or Report Card is grounds for removal from the production.
- Only the stage manager is allowed to have a cell phone backstage. All others should remain with your belongings. Parents have the GroupMe information and can message directors regarding any emergencies.
- Food must be brought for rehearsal. Do not ask others for their food and do not have parents drop off food during rehearsal times.
- Provide costume pieces on time. An “inspo board” will be posted by the end of September.
- **Do not make any major changes to your appearance without first consulting Mrs. Loy.** This includes haircuts, styles, and hair color. No non-traditional hair colors should be worn by any cast members until after production.
- Great behavior in class is expected at all times. If directors are notified of negative behaviors, consequences will be had. We are role models at KLMS. Missing rehearsal due to detention is grounds for immediate dismissal from a production.
- Be on time to rehearsal and be picked up on time from rehearsal. I always let students out on time.
- Fighting, harassment, excessive absences, missing mandatory rehearsals, ISS placement, OC placement, violation of digital citizenship, excessive referrals, and/or any other behaviors deemed drastic by the directors is grounds for immediate dismissal from the KLMS OAP.
