From the website: “History comes alive in the enchanted 53-acre New Market Village as all of Europe comes to pay homage to Queen Katherine on her birthday. Hundreds of costumed performers lead you into continuous laughter and learning. Students will meet Kings and Queens of three countries, William Shakespeare and Spanish Conquistadors. ## Reminders:

- Be at KLMS at 6:15am! We leave at 6:30 with or without you! No refunds! Sleep on the bus!
- No MONSTER drinks or energy drinks! Only drinks with screw tops also! (Fewer spills that way)
- Let Mrs. Loy know if you get carsick! Sit up front!
- Expect to sleep on the ride up! There will be a movie started an hour or two into the trip and on the way back.
- Check the weather (which is always changing!). Wear layers!! It gets cold on the bus! Bring a blanket and pillow!
- Bring extra clothes in case it's muddy on the grounds! You don't want wet or dirty clothes on during the ride back.
- We'll probably stop at a 7-11 or something for a QUICK pit stop. You may bring extra cash for a QUICK snack purchase.
- You are NOT allowed to text friends or waste cell phone battery on trivial reasons. You are allowed to have your phone on you for the sole purpose of getting hold of Mrs. Loy in an emergency or if an adult is looking for you!
- Bring a backpack with a bottle of water – it'll save you cash when you're dying of thirst!
- Parents- please be prepared to pick your child up between 6:30-7:00. Students will be allowed to call/ text when we are about 20 minutes out.
- Food in the park tends to be \$2-\$6 each item. \$20 for food is normal. Toys and other purchases tend to be ridiculously overpriced but fun.
- \$40 is a nice round number for a total on this trip to have. But they'll spend whatever they bring...
